### **INCLUSION OF ITALY IN PH'S RED LIST**

Pursuant to Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-MEID) Resolution No. 151-A, s. 2021 dated 28 November 2021, the Consulate General of the Republic of the Philippines in Milan informs the public of the following:

Effective 28 November 2021 and until 15 December 2021. Italy is placed in the RED LIST for purposes of international inbound travel to the Philippines.

All inbound international passengers to the Philippines, REGARDLESS of vaccination status, who come from or have been to Italy within 14 days prior to arrival to the Philippines shall NOT be allowed entry.

Passengers already in transit and all those who have been to RED LIST countries/jurisdictions/territories within 14 days immediately preceding arrival to the Philippines, who arrive before 0001H (12:01 a.m.) of 30 November 2021 shall be allowed entry. However, they shall undergo facility-based quarantine for 14 days, with testing on the 7th day, with day 1 being the date of arrival, notwithstanding a negative RT-PCR test result.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, passengers who have already arrived prior to 28 November 2021 and are currently undergoing quarantine pursuant to the classifications of their country of origin, as the case may be, shall complete their respective testing and quarantine protocols.

All passengers, whether Filipinos or foreigners, merely transiting through the countries in the Red List shall not be deemed as having come from or having been to said country if they stayed in the airport the whole time and were not cleared for entry into such country by its immigration authorities.

Those affected are advised to get in touch with their respective airlines/carriers on the appropriate measures to take.
