

PHILIPPINE CONSULATE GENERAL IN MILAN VISITS CUNEO TO RENDER CONSULAR SERVICES

19 June 2022- Consul General Bernadette Therese C. Fernandez led an eleven-member team on 18 and 19 June 2022 to visit Cuneo to render mobile consular services to Filipinos residing in Cuneo and nearby provinces in the Piemonte region.

A total of 423 transactions were processed, namely: 228 transactions for passport civil registry, Philippine citizenship reacquisition and retention, certification and legalization of documents, 130 transactions for the Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA) and 65 transactions for the Social Security System.

In addition, over 240 passports were distributed to Filipinos residing in the Piemonte region (Cuneo, Turin, Asti, Alba, Biella).
