TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF TRAVEL INTO THE PHILIPPINES OF NON-FILIPINOS AND RETURNING OVERSEAS FILIPINOS (ROFs) WHO ARE NON-OVERSEAS FILIPINO WORKERS (NON-OFWs)

The Philippine Consulate General in Milan informs the public of the following:

In light of the efforts to prevent the entry of SARS-COV2 variants from other countries and the further rise of cases, the number of inbound international passengers/arrivals in the Philippines is limited to only One Thousand Five Hundred (1,500) persons per day and the **entry of Foreign Nationals and Returning Overseas Filipinos who are non-OFWs beginning 00:01H of 20 March 2021 until 19 April 2021 is TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED**, except for the following:.

1. Holder of 9(E) visas;
2. Medical Repatriation and their escort/s duly endorsed by the Department of Foreign Affairs – Office of the Undersecretary for Migrant Workers' Affairs (OUMWA) or the Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA);
3. Distressed Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) duly endorsed by the Department of Foreign Affairs – Office of the Undersecretary for Migrant Workers' Affairs (OUMWA); and
4. Emergency, humanitarian, and other analogous cases approved by the National Task Force for COVID-19.

Non-essential travel is still not recommended to prevent COVID-19 transmission.
